Scholarship related Policy Documents

Swami Vivekananda Scholarship Eligibility Policy

1. 60% marks in aggregate in the last qualifying examination from West Bengal Council for Higher Secondary Education/Madrassa Education for Higher Secondary level or Under Graduate level Scholarship.
2. A family's annual income should not be above Rs. 2.5 lakh.
3. The applicant needs to be a West Bengal citizen.

Oasis Scholarship Eligibility Policy

1. Students must belong to SC or ST or OBC community.
2. The family income of SC / ST students should be less than or equal to ₹2.5 LPA.
3. Students belonging to the OBC category, their family income should be less than ₹1 LPA.

Aikyashree Scholarship Eligibility Criteria

A. Post-matric Scholarship

1. Only minority students can apply.
2. The applicant needs to be a West Bengal citizen.
3. Enrolling in an educational institution approved by the Central Government, the University of the State, the Board of Education, or the Council is necessary.
4. Students must score at least 50% of the percentile or an equivalent grade in the last exam.
5. A family's annual income should not be above Rs. 2 lakh.

B. SVMCM Scholarship

1. Only minority students can apply.
2. The applicant needs to be a West Bengal citizen.
3. Enrolling in an educational institution approved by the Central Government, the University of the State, the Board of Education, or the Council is necessary.
4. Students must score at least 60% of the percentile or an equivalent grade in the last exam.
5. A family's annual income should be above Rs. 2 lakh.

C. Talent Support Program (TSP)

1. Only minority students can apply.
2. The applicant needs to be a West Bengal citizen.
3. Enrolling in an educational institution approved by the Central Government, the University of the State, the Board of Education, or the Council is necessary.
4. Students score less than 50% of the percentile in the last exam.
5. A family's annual income should not be above Rs. 2 lakh.

Kanyashree Prakalpa

1. Only female students can apply.
2. The applicant needs to be a West Bengal citizen.
3. Enrolling in an educational institution approved by the Central Government, the University of the State, the Board of Education, or the Council is necessary.
