- Students may apply for Doctoral Programme, if they secure the required percentage of marks in PG.
- Completing Bengali Honours make students eligible for pursuing their career in Journalism, Translation related works, Publishing Houses etc.
- They can seek employment as translators, as proofreaders, as editors in magazines or journals, as book reviewer, as radio jockey, as news anchor, news reader, anchor of television shows, as content writer, content maker, dialogue and script writers in the film industries and so on.

## BENGALI HONOURS COURSE OUTCOME (CO)

### BNGHCC01: Bangla Bhasar udvob o parichay

This course provided a brief introduction to the history of Bengali language.  
Learning outcomes :

- Students will learn about the origin of Bengali language in the historical context, how Bengali language originated from the Indo-European family of languages and changed over time and how it varies from one place to another.
- Different styles and techniques of Bengali language and functional Bengali dialects, their classification and chronological changes, Phonological and Morphological Characteristics of Bengali Dialects.

#### **BNGHCC04: Chaitanya Jiban O Mangalkabya path**

- This course offers an organized method for achieving knowledge about Rhetoric and Prosody.
- It gives detailed knowledge about the importance of Rhetoric and Prosody while studying prose or poetry.
- It gives description and classification of Rhetoric and Prosody and practical lessons of Rhetoric and Prosody.
- It introduces the foundation of Prosody along with the basic knowledge of linguistics and aesthetics of language.
- It introduces the Indian Idea and practices of Rhetoric and Prosody.
- It gives the basic knowledge to interpret Modern Bengali Poems.

- Students will be able to understand the definition and classify the different types of forms of Bengali essays.

- Students will be able to differentiate a novel from a short story.
- It gives a fundamental idea about the analysis of a novel, narrative fiction in prose.

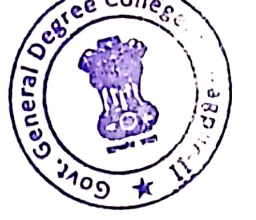
