BENGALI GENERAL COURSE OUTCOME (CO)

(3 Tier Examination Pattern)

Paper-1: Sahityer Itihas, Bhasatotwo, Chondo, Alankar

This course provided a brief introduction to the history of Bengali, Sanskrit and English Literature. Learning outcomes:

- The objective of the course intends to provide a detailed and comprehensive knowledge about the Origin, evolution and development of Bengali literature.

- This course gives the basic knowledge of the origin and history of the Bengali Prose.
- It helps to learn the history of Bengali poetry.
- This course deals with the forms and features of novels.
- Students will be able to know the origin and history of Drama.

- This course provides insights on Vaisnava Padabali, Vaisnava Religion, Philosophy, religious literature and its social values.
- Students can learn about the eminent poets of Vaishnava Padabali like Vidyapati, Chandidas, Gyanadas and Govindadas.
- This course provides insights on Shakta Padabali, Shakta Religion, Philosophy, religious literature and its social values.
- Students will learn the work of eminent poets of SHAKTA PADABALI with special notes to Ramprasad Sen and Kamalakanta Bhattacharya.
- Students will be able to know the transformation of imagery and development of other aesthetic trends from a colonial perspective of renaissance.
- Students will be able to know the understanding of semiotics in poetry through a post-colonial thread starting from the modern poetry till late sixties.

- It imparts mature understanding about the challenging facts and conflicts between the society and individuals.
- Students will know the various types of novel and their characteristics.
- Students will learn about the origin of the short story.
- Students will be able to analysis short stories.
- Students come to know about the short stories of different writers and their writing styles.
- Students will be equipped with deep understanding of the selected essays in different aspects.

Paper-4: Mongolkabyo, Chelebhulano chora, Moimonsingho gitika-Mohua pala, Onubadchorcha, biggapon, proof reading, onucched rochona

- It gives the basic knowledge about the classification and structure of Mangalkavya.
- Students will learn the socio-economic and cultural history of that period and the social impact of mangalkavyas, like Manasamangal in the medieval period.
