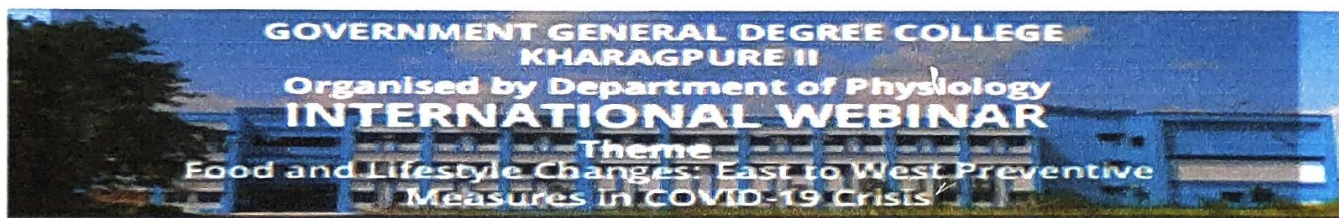
Title: Food and Lifestyle Changes: East to West Preventive Measures in COVID-19 Crisis

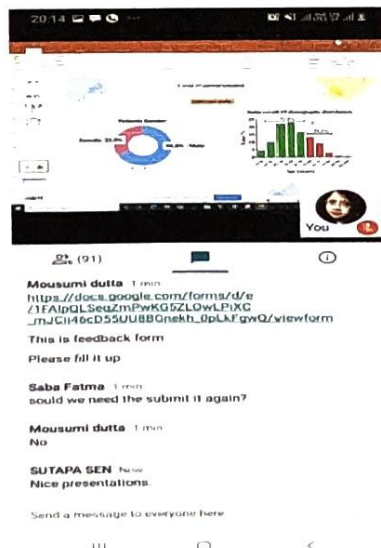
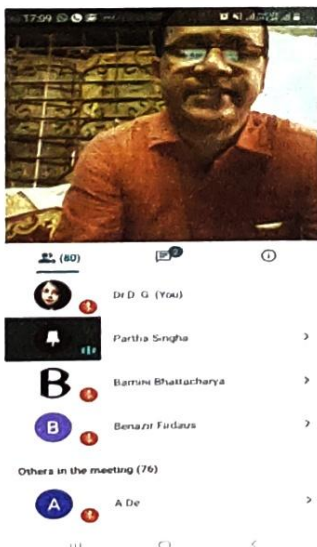


