A Report on Waste Management

Our institution follows environmental friendly steps to dispose the waste produced.

Solid waste management

We collect the solid wastes and dump them into two separate pits within the college campus. The bio-degradable and the non-biodegradable wastes are segregated and disposed off in the two different pits following safety measures.

Liquid waste management

The institution ensures minimum wastage of drinking water.

The wastage water from different sources is reused for purposes like gardening and cleaning.

Rain water harvesting for watering the plants of the medicinal plants' garden is an environment friendly initiative adopted by us.

The liquid wastes from the laboratories are collected in separate bottles. We have two such tanks for collecting the wastes from the four laboratories. The sand tanks are maintained properly.

Biomedical waste management

Separate dustbins are maintained for collecting biomedical wastes. The biomedical wastes are handled obeying safety protocols.

E-waste management

E-wastes generated are disposed properly.

Waste recycling system

Awareness programmes for waste disposal adopting recycle measures are conducted from time to time with the help of NSS unit of the college.

Hazardous Chemicals

The discarded acids and formalin from the laboratories of the institution are properly treated and neutralized before draining them into the wash basins. The drainage pipes from the wash basins of laboratories empty into sand filled tanks.
