Waste Management Procedures:

1. Waste Segregation: Recyclables (paper, plastic, glass, metal etc.)
Non-recyclables (landfill waste etc.)
Organics (food waste, garden waste etc.)

2. Waste Disposal: Recyclables: Sent to recycling facilities
Non-recyclables: Sent to landfills
Organics: Composted or sent to organic waste facilities

3. Hazardous Waste: Identified and stored separately.
Disposed with proper care and safety measures.
