2. General information and guidelines for online admission to UG Courses (2024-2025) :

- i) Two phases of Admission procedure 2024-25 through Centralized Portal has already been completed. This third phase is a continuation of the same, but this phase will be conducted through the college website and Management System. <https://ggdckgp2.collegeadmission.org.in>
- ii) Multiple payments received during e-Admission process for the same course/category due to some technical fault, will be considered for refund. Candidates are requested to go through the General Information and Guidelines for online admission 2024-25 available at the college website <https://ggdckharagpur2.ac.in> and also in the web-portal <https://ggdckgp2.collegeadmission.org.in> before filling up the form.
- iii) **Candidates are instructed not to report physically to the college before the schedule of physical document verification.**
- iv) The admission to the 1st year Undergraduate Programmes in the academic session 2024-2025 under CURRICULUM & CREDIT FRAMEWORK FOR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES (CCFUP) will be taken according to the UGC norms and guidelines of the Vidyasagar University.
- v) Those who are willing to take admission to this college are instructed to visit our college website <https://ggdckharagpur2.ac.in> and <https://ggdckgp2.collegeadmission.org.in> regularly.
- vi) All applicants must register through the Government General Degree College Kharagpur-II online admission portal <https://ggdckgp2.collegeadmission.org.in>.
- vii) All the undergraduate admissions for 2023-2024 will be administered **only through this portal.**
- viii) **There is no offline admission** for any applicant. Only eligible applicants, who have registered online through the admissions portal <https://ggdckgp2.collegeadmission.org.in> can be considered for admission.
- ix) The online admission process would be done based on merit points. Prospective students would not be called for counseling or verification of documents during the process of admission. No physical presence will be required at the college for admission.
- x) The admission to the Undergraduate Courses are to be made online. For Online admission, students must provide their own email ID & mobile number as the college authority will contact the candidate only through the provided email ID & mobile number, **if required**. They are Not required to come before physical document verification.
- xi) Verification of the documents will be done only according to the given schedule. Admission will be cancelled if the documents are found not in conformity with the declaration in the forms submitted online. This is according to the rule of the Government of West Bengal and the Vidyasagar University.
- xii) If the information provided by the candidate during online admission process is found to be wrong or false at any stage, his/her admission is liable to be cancelled.
- xiii) Admission to any course of the college is provisional and is subject to the final approval of the Vidyasagar University.
- xiv) Anti-ragging declaration as mandated by the UGC is to be furnished by every student and her guardian according to the norms.
- xv) Category Certificates (whenever applicable) issued only by appropriate authority of the Government of West Bengal will be considered valid. PWD candidates must have valid Disability certificate issued by competent authority. Original Disability certificate along with self-attested photocopy should be produced at the time of document verification. Percentage of reservation to each reserved category follows the Reservation policy of Government of West Bengal.
- xvi) The candidates who have taken admission elsewhere will be admitted to this college provisionally. However, transfer certificate or admission cancellation certificate from the previous institution must be submitted within the stipulated time as fixed by the College. Admission to this college otherwise may be treated as cancelled.

5. Eligibility criteria for admission in U.G. Courses:

Admission criteria, In-take capacity etc. shall be governed according to the guidelines issued by the Government of West Bengal and Vidyasagar University as applicable time to time. Proposed basic admission criteria applicable only for UG Admission for session 2024-25 with respect to introduction of CCFUP are as follows:

- i) Candidate passing Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent board/council are eligible for admission in the undergraduate programmes with Single Major and Multidisciplinary Studies under CCFUP within 3 (Three) consecutive academic sessions (i.e. **2024/2023/2022**) from the date of passing the qualifying examination. However, a candidate passing 10+2 level Examination before 2021 with above mentioned criteria can also apply after getting special permission from the Secretary, UG Council of Vidyasagar University, Paschim Medinipur.
- ii) Candidate passing Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) from Vocational stream conducted by the respective Board/ Council for vocational studies or any other equivalent board/council are eligible for admission in the undergraduate programmes in Multidisciplinary Studies only within 3 (Three) consecutive academic sessions from the date of passing the qualifying examination.
- iii) Candidate must have passed in 5 (Five) recognized subjects (excluding Environmental Studies) including at least one language subject in the qualifying examination.
- iv) Students who have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent examination with minimum 45% marks in the Aggregate (to be calculated by adding the marks obtained in 'Best Five' subjects excluding Environmental Studies) along with pass in the subject/related subject or 50% marks in the subject or related subject are eligible to apply for admission in the Single Major (Honours/Honours with Research) programmes.
- v) Students carrying pass marks in Higher Secondary or equivalent examination with at least pass in five subjects (excluding Environmental Studies) are eligible to apply for Multidisciplinary programmes under CCFUP. Students from Vocational stream are eligible to apply for Multidisciplinary Studies only fulfilling the other criteria.
- vi) Students who have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent examination with minimum 45% marks in the Aggregate (to be calculated by adding the marks obtained in "Best Five" subjects excluding Environment Studies) or 50% marks in the subject or related subject are eligible to apply for admission in the Honours course.
- vii) Admission be done on merit basis and merit point for admission in honours course is to be calculated by adding 10% of total marks obtained in the Best Five subjects excluding Environment Studies at Higher Secondary / Equivalent examination and the marks obtained in the subject or related subject in which the admission in honours course is sought.
- viii) Merit point for admission in Multidisciplinary course is to be calculated by adding the marks obtained in Best Five subjects excluding Environment Studies of Higher Secondary/equivalent examinations.
- ix) If any student of Science stream in Higher Secondary /equivalent examination apply for honours course in Bengali /English, his /her merit point is to be calculated proportionately by deducting marks obtained in the practical examination.
- x) Any candidate seeking admission in Lab based subjects he /she must have obtained pass marks in those subjects /relevant subjects in H.S. level.

5.4. Tie-Breaking Criterion

If more candidates score same Merit Point, preference will be given to applicant who scores higher marks in applied subject, in this way, if more candidates have same merit points and same marks in applied subject; preference will be given to applicant who scores higher marks in 1st Language.

6. Application Process for Online Admission

- i) All Applications should be made ONLINE.
- ii) Application Fee : NIL
- iii) Maximum Five (05) Applications can be submitted.
- iv) Follow step by step instruction for online form fill-up:
 - 1) First applicants have to register themselves by submitting some basic information in the portal <https://ggdckgp2.collegeadmission.org.in>
 - 2) Upload scanned Colour Photo (size 5-80 KB) & Signature (size 5-50 KB) (in .JPG/JPEG),
 - 3) Once logged in, Click on “Apply” and fill all the fields carefully.
 - 4) After filling, click “Submit” to submit the first application form. No edit is allowed after the final

submission.

- 5) Upload scanned (PDF, within 200 KB) Admit of 10th standard examination, Admit of 12th standard examination, Mark-sheet of 10+2 standard examination, AADHAAR card, Caste/Category certificate (if any)
- 6) After the documents uploading, more applications (upto maximum total five) can be submitted by clicking “Apply Another”.
- 7) After successful submission of Form/s take print out of all the submitted forms and keep them safe.
- 8) Merit list will be published in due course and selected students have to take admission accordingly, failing which their name will not be considered in the successive merit list,
- 9) After getting admission payment link, candidate have to Pay admission Fees for securing their admission.

7. Documents Required During Verification

The following documents have to be required/submitted along with the printed form at the time of **commencement of Semester-I classes:**

- i) Two copies of recent stamp size photograph.
- ii) Original and Self-attested Photocopy of Admit card of Madhyamik/Proof of age.
- iii) Original and Self-attested Photocopy of Mark-sheet of qualifying Examination at Secondary/Madhyamik level.
- iv) Original and Self-attested Photocopy of Mark-sheet of qualifying Examination at (10+2) level.
- v) Original and Self-attested Photocopy of Registration Certificate of qualifying Examination at (10+2) Level.
- vi) Original and Self-attested Photocopy of Caste/Category (SC/ST/OBC- A/OBC-B) and PWD certificates (where applicable).
- vii) Original School Leaving Certificate from Head of the Institution from where he/she passed the (10+ 2) level Examination. (The candidate is instructed to keep photocopy of the School Leaving Certificate for his/her requirement).
- viii) Original and Self-attested Registration Certificate of earlier passed out candidates (2021/2022) if registered previously to any University.
- ix) Original and Self-attested photocopy of Aadhaar card.
- x) Permission letter from Vidyasagar University if candidate has passed 10+2 on or before 2021 (where applicable).
- xi) Print copies of payment slip (Online payments of Admission Fees).
- xii) Kanyashree ID with proof for the female candidates.
